

## Texas Tax Amnesty Program

The Texas Comptroller has announced that the Texas Tax Amnesty Program will run from May 1, 2018 through June 29, 2018 affording taxpayers with relief from penalties and interest for tax delinquencies. The amnesty applies to tax periods prior to January 1, 2018 and only includes previously unreported tax liabilities and tax periods that are not currently under or scheduled for audit review. The amnesty includes most tax types including motor fuel taxes. The amnesty does not apply to: taxes not administered by the Comptroller, local motor vehicle taxes, IFTA taxes, Public Utility Commission gross receipts assessments, unclaimed property payments, accounts which have been certified to the Attorney General, accounts currently in litigation and accounts reduced to judgment. In addition to filing past due reports and paying past due taxes, the amnesty can also be used to register for taxes that should have been reported.
